Day 1: Barcelona to Carcassonne, France, via Queribus and Peyrepertuse (visiting castles and historical sights); hotel, Donjon Best Western (breakfast included).

Day 2: tour Albi and Mazamet (visiting castles and historical sights), return to Carcassonne; hotel, Donjon Best Western (breakfast included).

Day 3: depart Carcassonne for LaVella, Andorra, via Cloister of St. Hilaire and Montsegur (visiting castles and historical sights); hotel, Crowne Plaza Andorra (breakfast included).

Day 4: morning for shopping in Andorra; depart noon for Cardona, Spain; hotel, Parador de Cardona (restored castle; includes farewell banquet, and breakfast).

Day 5: depart for the Monastery of Montserrat; return to Barcelona dropping off in the center and at the airport; reservations can be made at the Best Western at the airport (hotel not included).
